BASEBALL FIELD BACKSTOP EXEMPTION

Dear Rick:

Enclosed is an Application for Exemption From Site Plan Review form for the Baseball Backstop extension at Cheverus High School, on Ocean Avenue. The High School is making the following improvements to their baseball field on the southerly side of the campus:

1. Extension of the existing 16' high backstop, with overhang, 20' long toward the first-base dugout. This extension is intended to decrease the probability of baseballs leaving Cheverus property.
2. Connection of the backstop to the dugouts on either side by use of 4' high chain link fencing and swing-gates. This fencing will improve the safety and aesthetics of the facility for participants and spectators.

The school intends to begin installation in early spring 2008, with completion intended for May 8, 2008. Please expedite this review as much as possible, so the improvements may be made before the upcoming baseball season. Call us with any questions.

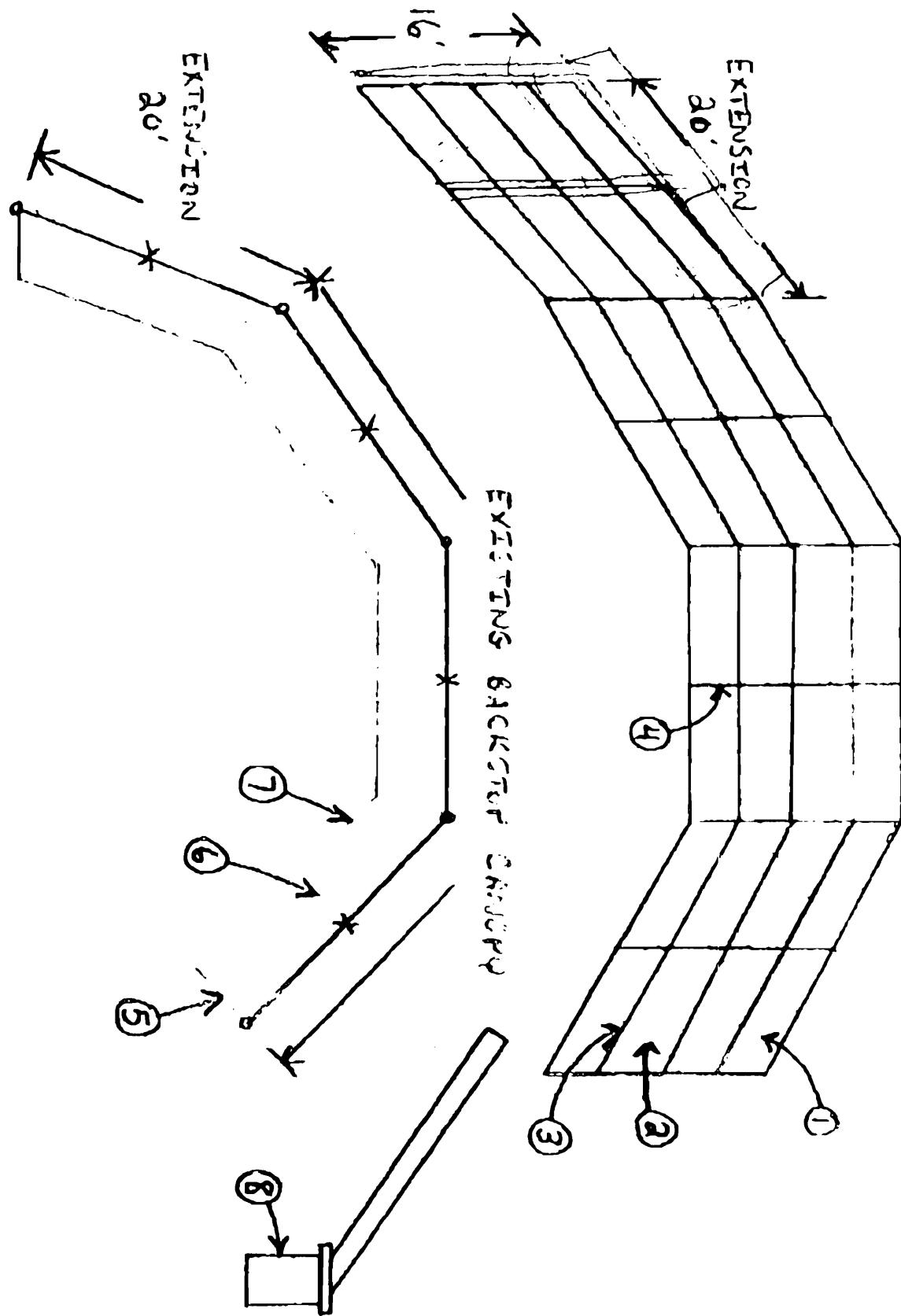

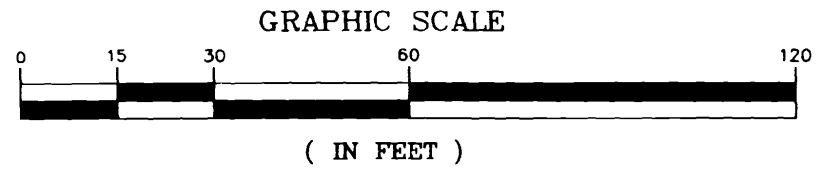
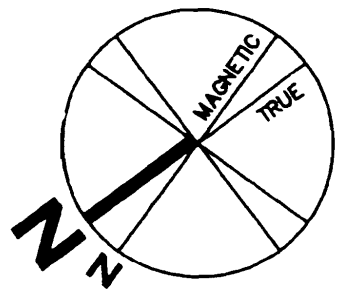
