I made a visit to Back Cove Estates on my lunch hour this afternoon. Jackson Tree Service was still there. I spoke with the owner Lee Jackson. They were trimming the bottom third of maybe a 1/2 dozen trees in the Shoreland area. Branches were extended out over the interior roadway and were hitting the tops of some SUVs. The branch cuts were basically only toward the roadway and a small parking area in the vicinity. This activity is permissible under our regulations DEP regulations. I checked out the area and could see no stumps. I determined that their activity was not a violation. All the trees looked pretty healthy. They should not be harmed by the trimming activity.
