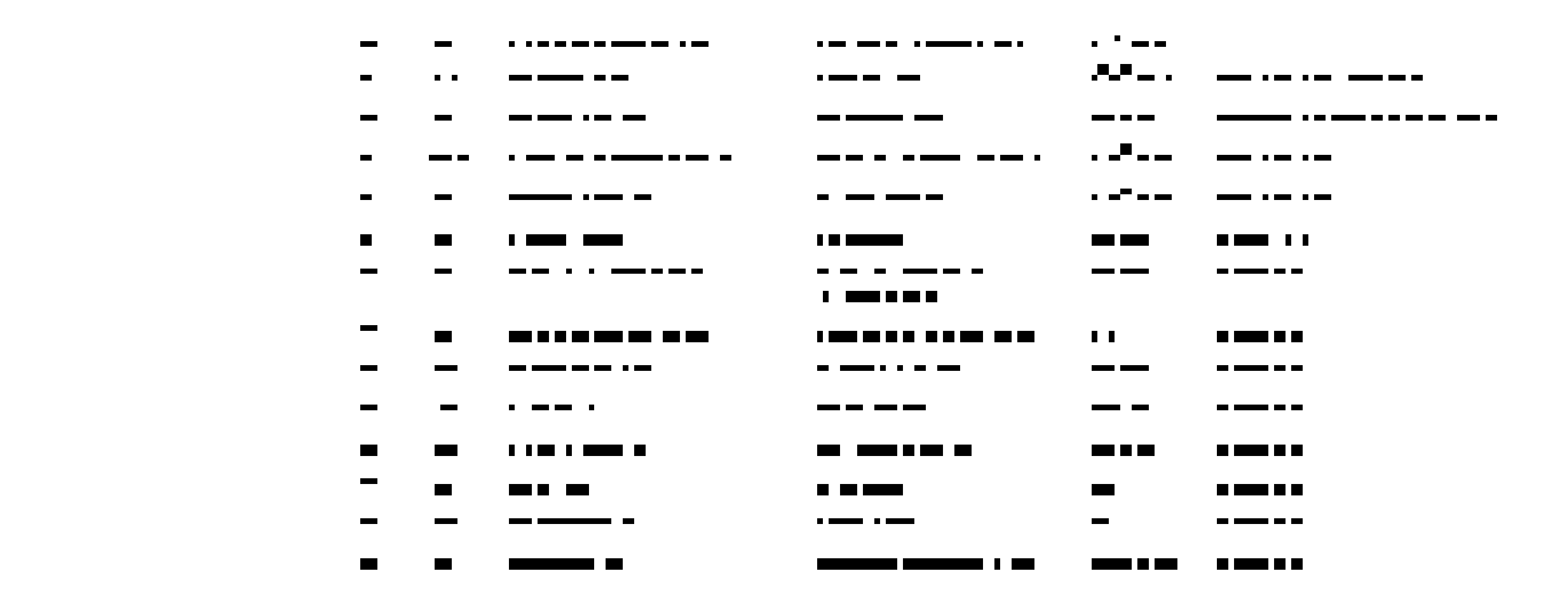




IMMEDIATELY TO THE AGENCY AND THE CONTRACTOR TO ADJUST.

2. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE AND MARK THE LOCATIONS OF WHICH THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY TO THE AGENCY AND THE CONTRACTOR TO ADJUST.

3. PAVING, CURBING, UTILITY WORK, AND OTHER CONSTRUCTION AS A RESULT OF THE LANDSCAPE OPERATIONS SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACTOR.

4. AREAS RECEIVING PLANTINGS AND SHRUB AND GROUND COVER SHALL BE MULCHED TO A DEPTH OF 2 INCHES OF CLEAN, UNIFORMLY GROUND HEMLOCK BARK MULCH. THE MULCH USED SHALL BE SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO SITE INSTALLATION.

5. FLOWER BEDS SHALL BE INSTALLED IN TOPSOIL.

6. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE AND MARK THE LOCATIONS OF WHICH THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY TO THE AGENCY AND THE CONTRACTOR TO ADJUST.

7. PLANT MATERIALS CAPABLE OF MEETING OR EXCEEDING THE SPECIFICATIONS STANDARDS FOR NURSERY SET FORTH BY THE AMERICAN NURSERYMEN.

8. BEDS SHALL BE NEARLY SQUARE OR RECTANGULAR. PLANTING BED LAYOUT AND APPROVAL PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

9. IF SUBSTITUTIONS ARE REQUIRED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY ARCHITECT PRIOR TO INSTALLATION. SUBSTITUTIONS SHALL BE OF SIMILAR BOTANICAL CHARACTERISTICS.
