With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Please read the conditions of approval that is attached to this permit!! Contact this office if you have any questions.**
- **Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.**

Any deviation from the final approved plans requires separate review and approval prior to work. 2) An inspection of the installation of the steel and concrete and structural bracing shall be conducted by a licensed engineer and a letter with his/her certification shall be submitted to this office stating compliance with the approved plans by the final inspection or CO. 3) Separate permits are required for any electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, heating appliances, including pellet/wood stoves, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process. 4) A final special inspection report with compliance letter shall be submitted prior to the final inspection or issuance of a certificate of occupancy. This report must demonstrate all deficiencies and corrective measures that were taken.
