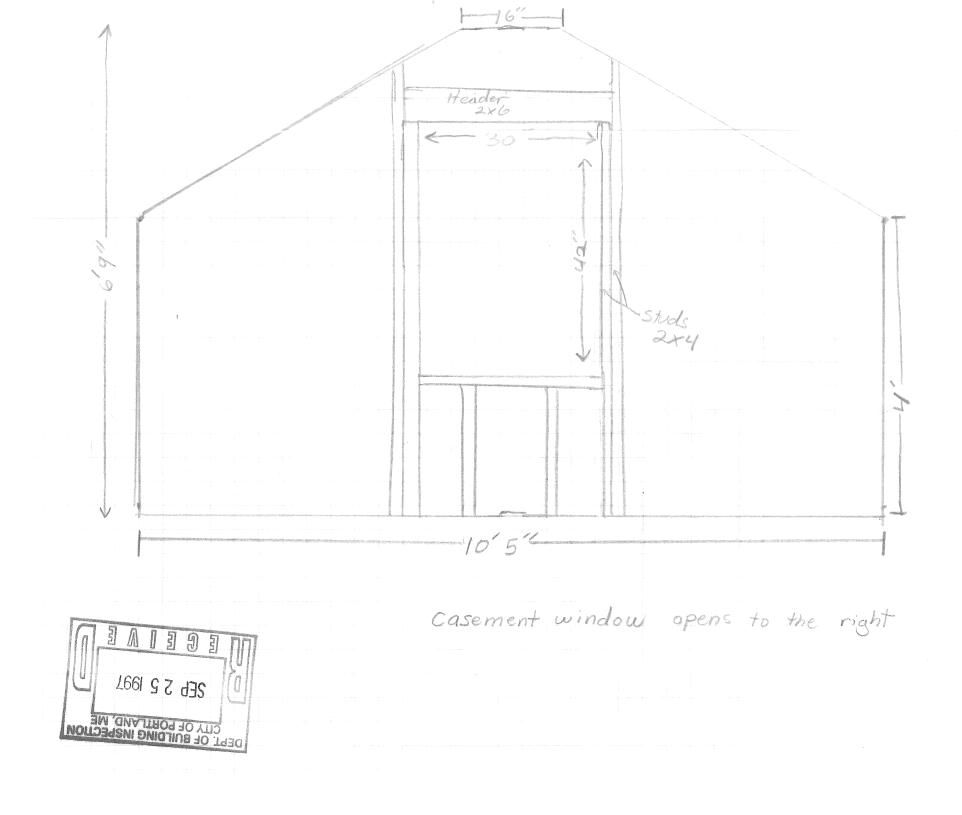

Proposed stairs would have a rise of 8 feet and a run of 7 feet 10 inches. They will be made with 2x6 stringers and 3/4 inch plywood underlayment. A 1 3/4 inch diameter hand rail will be attached to the left hand ( looking up the stairs) wall.

Total cost of stairs and windows with installation is 2000 dollars.
