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Alterations checklist

All of the following information is required. Date: 11/05/13 Checking off each item as you prepare your application package will ensure your package is complete and will help to expedite the permitting process.

The Maine Home Construction Contracts Act requires that any home construction or repair work for more than \$3000. in materials or labor must be based on a written contract unless the parties agree to exempt themselves. A sample contract is available on the City's website at www.portlandmaine.gov, in the Inspection Office, Room 315 of Portland City Hall or call (207)874-8703 to have one mailed to you.

One (1) complete set of construction drawings must include:

- Cross sections w/framing details
- Floor plans and elevations existing & proposed
- Detail removal of all partitions & any new structural beams
- Detail any new walls or permanent partitions
- Stair details including dimensions of: rise/run, head room, guards/handrails, baluster spacing
- Window and door schedules
- Foundation plans w/required drainage and damp proofing (if applicable)
- Detail egress requirements and fire separation/sound transmission ratings (if applicable)
- Insulation R-factors of walls, ceilings & floors & U-factors of windows per the IECC 2009
- Deck construction including: pier layout, framing, fastenings, guards, stair dimensions
- Electronic files in pdf format are also required
- Proof of ownership is required if it is inconsistent with the assessors records

Separate permits are required for internal & external plumbing, HVAC, and electrical installations.

If there are any additions to the footprint or volume of the structure, any new or rebuilt structures or, accessory detached structures a plot plan is required. A plot must include:

- The shape and dimension of the lot, footprint of the existing and proposed structure and the distance from the actual property lines. Structures include decks, porches; bow windows, cantilever sections and roof overhangs, sheds, pools, garages and any other accessory structures must be shown with dimensions if not to scale.
- Location and dimensions of parking areas and driveways
- A change of use may require a site plan exemption application to be filed.

Please submit all of the information outlined in this application checklist. If the application is incomplete, the application may be refused.
