But I think those distances, even plus or minus 5 feet, meet the setbacks by more than enough.

Thank you for sending. I know the steps will likely more than meet all required setbacks, but could you let me know the approximate setbacks of the steps from all four property lines? I looked on the tax maps and I think the step location would scale roughly 45' from the front, 25' from the right side, 40' from the left side, and 69' from the rear. Could you just confirm? Also, be sure when you apply for the deck later that you supply a full plot plan showing the boundaries of the property and the locations, dimensions, and setbacks of all existing & proposed structures.

As far as securing the door, that is actually a question for the building code people. You can ask Jon Rioux at 874-8702 or jrioux@portlandmaine.gov
