I am writing per the letter that I received and per our conversation on Friday, November 3, 2006 regarding the property that I own at 85 Morning Street. I have enclosed a copy the violations notice that I received.

1. Fire doors required on the 2<sup>nd</sup> front.

The second floor of this building is vacant and currently undergoing extensive renovations. There are 4 doors to that apartment. I have installed two fire doors on this 2<sup>nd</sup> floor apartment and have not installed the other two and will not be doing so as these doors are scheduled to be removed and the areas will be made into walls. My husband and I are doing this project ourselves as time permits due to our obligations to our jobs and will not rent this apartment until the renovations area complete and the doors are removed and made into walls.

2. Fire doors required on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor rear.

The third floor apartment is scheduled to be vacant by the first of the year and will also undergo extensive renovations. We will be installing fire doors on the third floor apartment and will also not rent it until they are installed.

3. Boiler protection required.

I am going to obtain several estimates on this project and will have boiler protection installed.

4. Debris inside building first floor rear.


The debris inside the first floor rear will be cleaned by the target compliance date on this letter of 11/21/06.
