CITY OF PORTLAND, MAINE

THE UNDERSIGNED, THE MUNICIPAL OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, MAINE, having taken into consideration the petition praying that the lines of Ray Street, between Washington Avenue and Allen Avenue be defined or relocated, have attended to that duty and now report thereon as follows, viz:-

Said Municipal Officers gave due and legal notice to all parties interested therein of the time and place they would meet to view the street or way to be laid out and hear all parties interested by posting five notices of their intentions at least seven days previous to the date of said hearing, one on a telephone or light pole at the corner of Washington Avenue and Ray Street, one on a telephone or light pole at the corner of Maine Avenue and Ray Street, and one on a telephone or light pole at the corner of Allen Avenue and Ray Street, one on the bulletin board in the basement of City Hall, and one on the bulletin board at the Cumberland County Court House, two being in the vicinity of the proposed street or way and two being public places in the City of Portland, and also by publishing said notice in two daily papers published in Portland, to wit: The Portland Press Herald and the Portland Evening Express, and having met pursuant to said notice at the corner of Maine Avenue and Ray Street on the 2nd day of August, A. D., 1957, at 8:45 o'clock in the forenoon, Daylight Saving Time, and having personally examined the way proposed and heard all parties interested therein, said Municipal Officers did thereupon determine and adjudge that the public convenience and necessity of the City requires that said street or public way should be relocated as proposed and accordingly we proceeded to relocate and did relocate said Ray Street as follows, viz:-

Beginning at a point in the northerly side line of Washington Avenue said point being distant easterly, measured on the said northerly side line of Washington Avenue 59.84 feet from the first angle in said side line westerly of Lawrence Avenue;
thence northeasterly and making an included angle of $90^{\circ}43\frac{1}{2}'$ through the north with the northwesterly direction of the said northerly side line of Washington Avenue a distance of 671.04 feet to a point;
thence northerly on a curve to the northwest with a radius of 109 feet and tangent to the last described course, a distance, measured on the arc of 131.27 feet to a point;
thence northwesterly on a course tangent to the last described course a distance of 952.64 feet to a point;
thence northwesterly and northerly on a curve to the northeast with a radius of 193.02 feet and tangent to the last described course a distance measured on the arc of 184.53 feet to a point;
thence northeasterly on a course tangent to the last described course a distance of 446.85 feet to a point;
thence northeasterly and making an included angle of $178^{\circ}43'$ through the west with the southwesterly direction of the last described course, a distance of 611.05;
thence north and northwesterly on a curve to the northwest with a radius of 206.35 feet and tangent to the last described course a distance measured on the arc of 196.76 feet to a point;

thence northwesterly on a course tangent to the last described course, a distance of 1081.94 feet to a point;
thence northwesterly and making an included angle of $179^{\circ}13'$ through the west with the southeasterly direction of the last described course a distance of 291.07 feet to a point;
thence northwesterly and making an included angle of $177^{\circ}49\frac{1}{2}'$ through the east with the southeasterly direction of the last described course a distance of 228.26 feet to a point;
thence northwesterly and making an included angle of $176^{\circ}40'$ through the east with the southeasterly direction of the last described course a distance of 320.80 feet;
thence northwesterly and making an included angle of $173^{\circ}18\frac{1}{2}'$ through the west with the southeasterly direction of the last described course a distance of 590.95 feet to a point in the southeasterly side line of Allen Avenue, said point being distant westerly, along the southeasterly side line of Allen Avenue 8.07 feet from the 2nd angle in said southeasterly side line of Allen Avenue easterly of Washington Avenue and making an included angle of $84^{\circ}33\frac{1}{2}'$ through the south with the westerly direction of the said southeasterly side line of Allen Avenue.

Said street to be fifty (50) feet wide and to lie equally on each side of the above described line.

Said street passes over land of the following persons:

Parties Unknown

and we have considered and estimated the damage sustained in their property by the several owners aforesaid and all other persons, by the relocation of said street and award the said parties as follows:-

To the said Parties Unknown the sum of NOTHING

for the damages sustained by them respectively, to be paid them by the City.

Said owners to have the right to remove and take away any buildings, fences and trees from the land so taken, within two months from and after the acceptance of said laying out by the City Council.

And we have this day filed with the City Clerk of said City at his office such laying out, with the boundaries and admeasurements aforesaid.
