I am in receipt of a sent application for a change of use for a home occupation for inhome day care. Please note that I am returning your application and attachments. I will also pass on information to you that any home occupation for over 5 children, although allowed under zoning, will result in more restrictive building code requirements. If you adjust you application to no more than five (5) children, you can avoid the stricter building code requirements.
