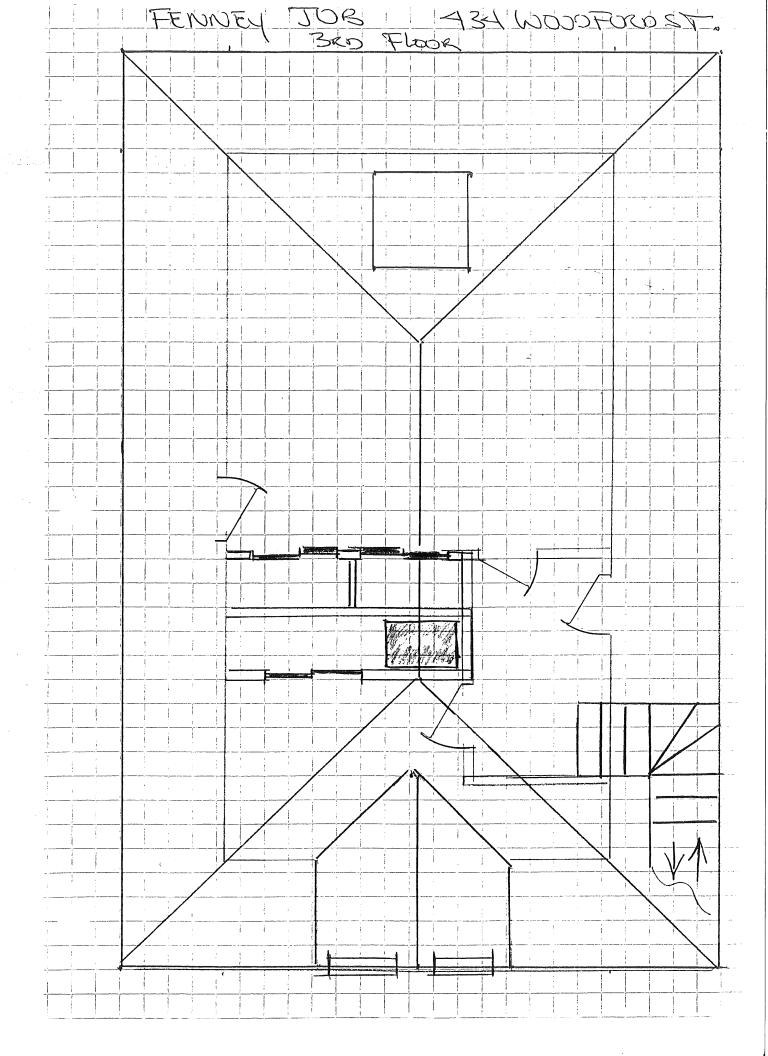

DEAR MR. HOFFSES,

HERE IS THE LETTER WHICH YOU REQUESTED REGARDING THE USE OF MY HOME AT 434 WOODFORDS STREET.

THE BUILDING HAS BEEN A TWO (2) UNIT BUILDING SINCE THE 1940'S. A FIRST FLOOR APARTMENT AND A SECOND FLOOR APARTMENT. IN PREVIOUS YEARS THE THIRD FLOOR SPACE WAS USED FOR A BEDROOM IN THE FRONT PORTION OF THE ATTIC AND FOR STORAGE IN THE REAR PORTION.

AT THIS TIME WE HAVE REQUESTED A BUILDING PERMIT SO AS TO ADD A SECOND BEDROOM TO THE THIRD FLOOR. WE WILL BE TOTALLY RENOVATING THE THIRD FLOOR IN ORDER TO BRING IT UP TO CODE.

THE ONLY EXCEPTION WHICH WE WOULD ASK IS THE THAT THE MINIMUM HEADROOM REQUIREMENT OF 80", IN THE EXISTING STAIRWAY, BE WAVED. DUE TO THE HIP ROOF CONSTRUCTION OF THE BUILDING, THE SLOPED PORTION OF THE CEILING IS LESS THAN THE 80" MINIMUM REQUIREMENT IN A SMALL SECTION OF THE EXISTING STAIRWAY.
