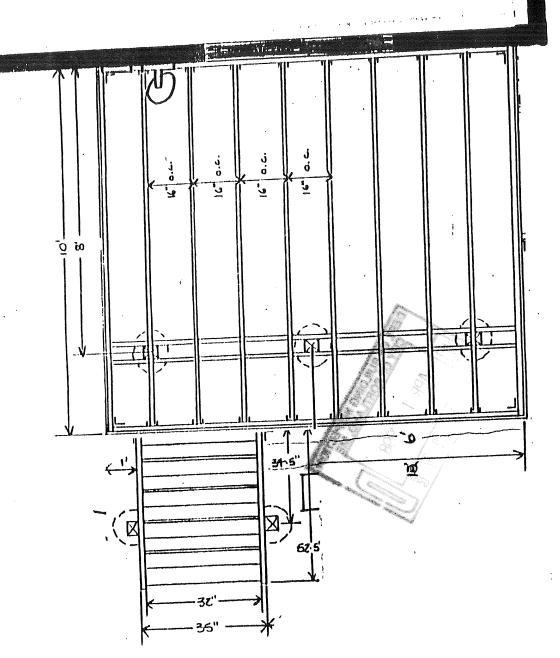

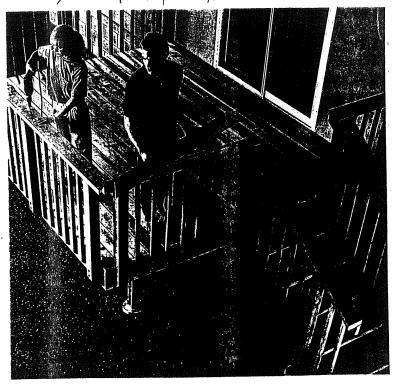

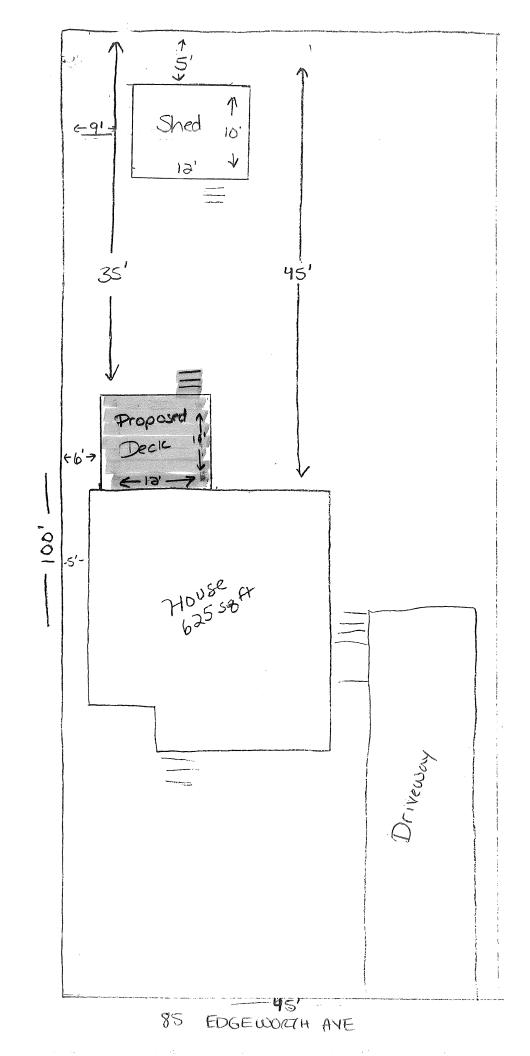

1. This permit does not excuse the applicant from meeting applicable State and Federal rules and laws. 2. Before concrete for foundation is placed, approvals from the Development Review Goordinator and Inspection Services must be obtained. (A 24 hour notice is required prior to inspection)			
3. Precaution must be taken to protect concrete from freezing.			
4. It is strongly recommended that a registered land surveyor check all foundation forms before concrete is placed. This is done to			
verify that the proper setbacks are maintained.			
5. Private garages located beneath habitable rooms in occupancies in Use Group R-1, R-2, R-3 or I-1 shall be separated from

- Guardrails & Handrails: A guardrail system is a system of building components located near the open sides of elevated walking **X** 8. surfaces for the purpose of minimizing the possibility of an accidental fall from the walking surface to the lower level. Minimum height all Use Groups 42", except Use Group R which is 36". In occupancies in Use Group A, B, H-4, I-1, I-2 M and R and public garages and open parking structures, open guards shall have balusters or be of solid material such that a sphere with a diameter of 4" cannot pass through any opening. Guards shall not have an ornamental pattern that would provide a ladder effect. (Handrails shall be a minimum of 34" but not more than 38". Use Group R-3 shall not be less than 30", but not more than 38".) Handrail grip size shall have a circular cross section with an outside diameter of at least 1 1/4" and not greater than 2".
 - 9. Headroom in habitable space is a minimum of 7'6".

 - The minimum headroom in all parts of a stairway shall not be less than 80 inches. (6'8") 11.
 - Every sleeping room below the fourth story in buildings of use Groups R and I-1 shall have at least one operable window or 12. exterior door approved for emergency egress or rescue. The units must be operable from the inside without the use of special knowledge or separate tools. Where windows are provided as means of egress or rescue they shall have a sill height not more than 44 inches (1118mm) above the floor. All egress or rescue windows from sleeping rooms shall have a minimum net clear opening height dimension of 24 inches (610mm).  - Each apartment shall have access to two (2) separate, remote and approved means of egress. A single exit is acceptable when it 13. exits directly from the apartment to the building exterior with no communications to other apartment units.
 - All vertical openings shall be enclosed with construction having a fire rating of at lest one (1)hour, including fire doors with self 14. closer's. (Over 3 stories in height requirements for fire rating is two (2) hours.)
 - The boiler shall be protected by enclosing with (1) hour fire-rated construction including fire doors and ceiling, or by providing 15. automatic extinguishment.
 - All single and multiple station smoke detectors shall be of an approved type and shall be installed in accordance with the 16.
