Things that make GLAMOUR POOLS & SPA different from our COMPETITORS:

We don't not use blocks under uprights.

These can cause your pool to move unevenly as the ground shifts below it, leaving a
potential for a ripped liner or a torn wall.

We use stone dust on the bottom of the pool.

- Sand makes it easier to leave footprints at the bottom of your pool.
- Stone dust creates a uniform structure that shifts as one unit, unlike blocks or bricks.

We use foam on top of the stone dust.

• This makes it easier on your feet, as well as your liner, making it harder for the liner to rip or tear.

We use pool cove around the perimeter of the pool.

- Pool cover creates a gradual slope for your liner, making it harder to rip or tear.
- Sand can get matted down and can go under the wall of your pool and cause winter damage.

We make an 18" shelf all around the outside of the pool.

 This gives your pool room to drip around the perimeter without causing corrosion to the stone dust below, which can cause your pool to tilt over time.
