


JOHN NORTON PERPOSED PERGOLA 101 FRANCES ST PORTLAND, ME

PERPOSED PERGOLA END VIEW




To help support the first beam while you're installing it, clamp a 2x4 o the front face of each porch post, approximately 13 in. from the ceiling photo 4, p. 32). Rest the beam on


top of the 2x4 supports and adjust its position up or down by moving the clamped 2x4s until the beam is level at 3-1/2-in. from the ceiling. Be sure that the posts are plumb as you drive 5-in. lag screws (two at each end) to attach the beam to the posts.

Set the two outer posts on their footings and use a long level and a 2x4 (or a laser level) to verify that the tops are level with each other and that they are even with the top edge of the installed beam. (You're going to need a helper.) Trim the posts as needed.
