I circulated a paper print out of your May 18 comment to the Board and then in my presentation I brought it to their attention. I also clarified that the existing building is proposed to be demolished. I also repeated what I have mentioned to you and I had written in the report - ie that the Historic Preservation Program Manager does not consider that this building meets the criteria for any historic designation.

There were no other members of the public who commented on this question.

None of the Board members commented on this issue at all and at the end of the workshop they indicated their support for the new building project subject to some traffic and stormwater issues being resolved.

From my perspective the question of demolition of the church is unlikely to be further considered by the Planning Board.
