#### **Conditions:**

- 1) Fireblocking is required to provide a cut off of all concealed draft openings (both vertical and horizontal) in combustible construction, see Sec. R302.11.
- 2) Bathrooms shall have a minimum ceiling height of 6 feet 8 inches at the center of the front clearance area for fixtures as shown in Figure R307.1. The ceiling height above fixtures shall be such that the fixture is capable of being used for its intended purpose. A shower or tub equipped with a showerhead shall have a minimum ceiling height of 6 feet 8 inches above a minimum area 30 inches by 30 inches at the showerhead.

R307.2 Bathtub and shower spaces. Bathtub and shower floors and walls above bathtubs with installed shower heads and in shower compartments shall be finished with a nonabsorbent surface. Such wall surfaces shall extend to a height of not less than 6 feet (1829 mm) above the floor.

The clear space in front of any water closet or bidet shall be not less than twenty-four (24) inches (610 mm).

3) Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms shall be installed in each area within or giving access to bedrooms. That detection must be powered by both the electrical service (plug-in or hardwired) in the building and battery.

Hardwired (non- ionization detection technology) interconnected battery backup smoke alarms shall be installed in each bedroom, protecting the bedrooms, and on every level.

- A field inspection will verify your current egress/ emergency escape, Smoke and Carbon Monoxide alarm arrangement and the City's minimal code requirements.
- 4) Separate permits are required for any electrical: plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.
