With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- Please read the conditions of approval that is attached to this permit!! Contact this office if you have any questions.
- Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.
- If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.
- 1. Footings/Setbacks prior to pouring concrete
- 2. Close In Elec/Plmb/Frame prior to insulate or gypsum
- 3. Final Inspection

The project cannot move to the next phase prior to the required inspection and approval to continue, REGARDLESS OF THE NOTICE OF CIRCUMSTANCES.

IF THE PERMIT REQUIRES A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY, IT MUST BE PAID FOR AND ISSUED TO THE OWNER OR DESIGNEE BEFORE THE SPACE MAY BE OCCUPIED.

#### **Conditions of Approval:**

#### Zoning

- 1. This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted. Any deviations shall require a separate approval before starting that work.
- 2. This property shall remain a single family dwelling. Any change of use shall require a separate permit application for review and approval.

#### Building

- 1. Separate permits are required for any electrical: plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.
- 2. A photoelectric Carbon Monoxide (CO) detector shall be installed in each area within or giving access to bedrooms. That detection must be powered by the electrical service (plug-in or hardwired) in the building and battery.
- Hardwired photoelectric interconnected battery backup smoke detectors shall be installed in all bedrooms, protecting the bedrooms, and on every level. A field inspection will verify your current smoke detector arraignment and the City's minimal code requirements.
- 4. Mechanical or natural ventilation is required in the bathroom.
- 5. Roof framing and collar/ rafter tie connection(s) must comply with Section R802.3 & R802.3.1.
- 6. See attached documentation for bathroom fixtures clearance and headroom requirements.
- 7. Note: 8 inch thick concrete tubes located at or greater than 4 feet below grade, (2) 2X10 inch P.T. Beams with a max span of 4 feet will be utilized.

#### Fire

- 1. All construction shall comply with City Code Chapter 10.
- 2. Hardwired Carbon Monoxide alarms with battery back up are required on each floor.
- 3. All smoke detectors and smoke alarms shall be photoelectric.




