Dear Laurie,

Thank you for taking the time to call me earlier today.

As discussed, the furniture that exists today at the Burger King location is being replaced in kind with a new look/materials. The booths will be the same/similar to the existing; all other furniture will be loose; and will include ADA height/width tables equaling 5% of total/minimum seating, and be of a height of minimum 28"/maximum 34" AFF. Such tables will have a minimum of 27" deep knee clearance height, and a minimum 30" wide clearance.

The new furniture will be as that attached.

If you have any other questions, I am happy to direct you to the contact person providing the furniture for further details/info should that be needed.

As for the Post Security Shipyard, my scope only included the addition of the railing similar to the others that currently exist; but I would presume that portioning of the existing furniture and seating meet the ADA guidelines, as this location was recently renovated within the past couple of years, to the best of my knowledge.
