Please find enclosed in this packet a series of (4) applications for signage for new construction at our FBO facility at the Portland Jetport as follows:

1. Freestanding Curb Sign
2. Main Entry Sign – Facing Parking Lot
3. Ramp Sign – Facing Air Traffic Landing Ramp – Directional
4. Roof Sign – Facing Air Traffic Runways – Directional
