Please see attached aerial view and site plan view noting the fixtures to which we are proposing to add banners.

The banners are stitched at top and bottom to create loops that slide onto the existing banner posts on the light poles.

I will ensure that we provide the flammability certificate right away.

With sign/banner permit applications we usually get a site plan that shows where the banners are located. From the picture provided, I can only see the first light pole. A goggle earth picture showing the light poles would suffice.

With banners we need a certificate of flammability to show that the material has been treated.

Finally we need details on how the banners will be attached to the light poles.
