This plan shall guide the planning and management of outdoor events at this venue on Thompson's Point.
- 3. C1 Site Plan.pdf:** This drawing illustrates the venue layout for concerts, including: tent location and sizes, stage location and size, entrance and egress locations and sizes, venue perimeter fencing, and administrative, operational, and concessions infrastructure.
- 4. C2 ParkingMap.pdf:** A "Parking and Pedestrian" map. In addition to the 700 parking spaces available on-site, we have agreements with off-site facilities that provide at a minimum an additional 1,300 spaces. A shuttle service will provide access to this off-site parking not within walking distance.
- 5. Q1-Q3 Certificates of Flammability** provided by Maine Bay Canvas, the provider and installer of the tents to be used.
