
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONSTRUCT TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCES AS SHOWN TO ACCESS THE WORK AREAS AND MAINTAIN THE EXISTING OVERALL TRAFFIC PATTERNS OF THE SITE. REFER TO SHEET C6-2 FOR LAYOUT AND GRADING OF THE INDIVIDUAL CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCES ALONG WITH ADDITIONAL SITE AND SECURITY INFORMATION. TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCES SHALL BE RETURNED TO THEIR EXISTING CONDITIONS UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE ARCHITECT AT THE COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.
- CONTRACTOR STAGING AREAS SHALL BE LOCATED AS SHOWN AND INCLUDE THE WEST EDGE OF THE EMPLOYEE PARKING LOT AND THE SURFACE PARKING LOT WEST OF THE PHASE II GARAGE SITE. ALL STAGING AND WORK AREAS SHALL BE SEGREGATED FROM PUBLIC AREAS BY TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES, CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES AND CONSTRUCTION BARRIERS AROUND THE TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION BARRIERS AROUND THE SITE AS NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE THE SEQUENCE OF WORK. IN AREAS OF SIGNIFICANT GRADE CHANGE WHERE A TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN ROUTE IS TO BE LOCATED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE PAVED RAMPS THAT COMPLY WITH ALL ADA REQUIREMENTS.
- IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR THE CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE A PEDESTRIAN ROUTE THROUGH THE EXISTING PHASE I GARAGE STRUCTURE. THE FIRST TWO BAYS OF PARKING SHALL BE RE-MARKED AS SHOWN FOR ONE WAY TRAFFIC MOVEMENT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT SPACE FOR A PEDESTRIAN ROUTE OUTSIDE OF THE CONSTRUCTION AREA. ONE SET OF AUTOMATED VEHICULAR ENTRY GATE EQUIPMENT AND ONE SET OF AUTOMATED VEHICULAR EXIT GATE EQUIPMENT SALVAGED FROM THE DEMOLISHED THREE LEVEL GARAGE STRUCTURE SHALL BE TEMPORARILY RELOCATED AS SHOWN TO PROVIDE FOR CONTROLLED SHORT TERM PARKING WITHIN THE PHASE I GARAGE STRUCTURE DURING CONSTRUCTION. AT THE COMPLETION OF THE PHASE I STRUCTURE, THE VEHICULAR GATE EQUIPMENT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THEIR TEMPORARY LOCATIONS AND INSTALLED IN THEIR PROPOSED PERMANENT LOCATIONS AS SHOWN ON THE FUNCTIONAL DESIGN DRAWINGS.






