Dear Mrs. Andrews,

As a representative for the Tate House Museum, a property of The National Society of the Colonial Dames of America in the State of Maine, I submit the enclosed plan for two signs at the Tate House Museum/Means House located on Westbrook Street in Portland. Signage is part of a larger effort to improve the appearance and use of the newly acquired Means House property. With the expanded space afforded by the Means House, the Colonial Dames intend to increase their educational outreach to the community. It has been determined that directional signage and museum information is needed to help visitors and guests. Currently, there is one small sign in front of the Captain Tate House.


As you know, the Tate House Museum and Means House are historic properties located within the Stroudwater Historic District. The Colonial Dames, who own the two houses, wish to install two signs. One of the two signs will stand along the stone walk leading to the entrance of the Means House, which is across the street from the Captain Tate House. The other sign will be installed at the intersection of Waldo and Congress Streets. The locations of the proposed signs are shown in highlighter on the attached Site Plan (scale: 1" = 25'00").

It is the intention of the Museum Properties Committee to install signs that will clearly direct visitors to the Tate House Museum /Means House without intruding on the historic character of the Stroudwater neighborhood. It is felt that placing a sign at Waldo Street will direct visitors by a less congested route to the Houses, avoiding the Westbrook Street intersection which is extremely busy.

The layout and wording of the signs is as shown on the enclosed diagram. The primary signs will be approximately 36" x 36" painted wood. They will be hung by black painted metal brackets on eight foot high unpainted pressure treated posts. The signs will have a light blue background (Sherwin Williams, Sweeping Blue) with black lettering and border. Light blue was chosen because it is the Colonial Dames "color." A sample of the blue color is included with this application. There will be smaller, attachable signs measuring approximately 6" x 36" which will be hung below the Means House sign highlighting specific tours and functions. The small signs will be attached on the days of particular activities. The sign at the Means House will be lit by small spotlights that will be on stakes set in the ground. In the future, a garden will be installed around the light fixtures.

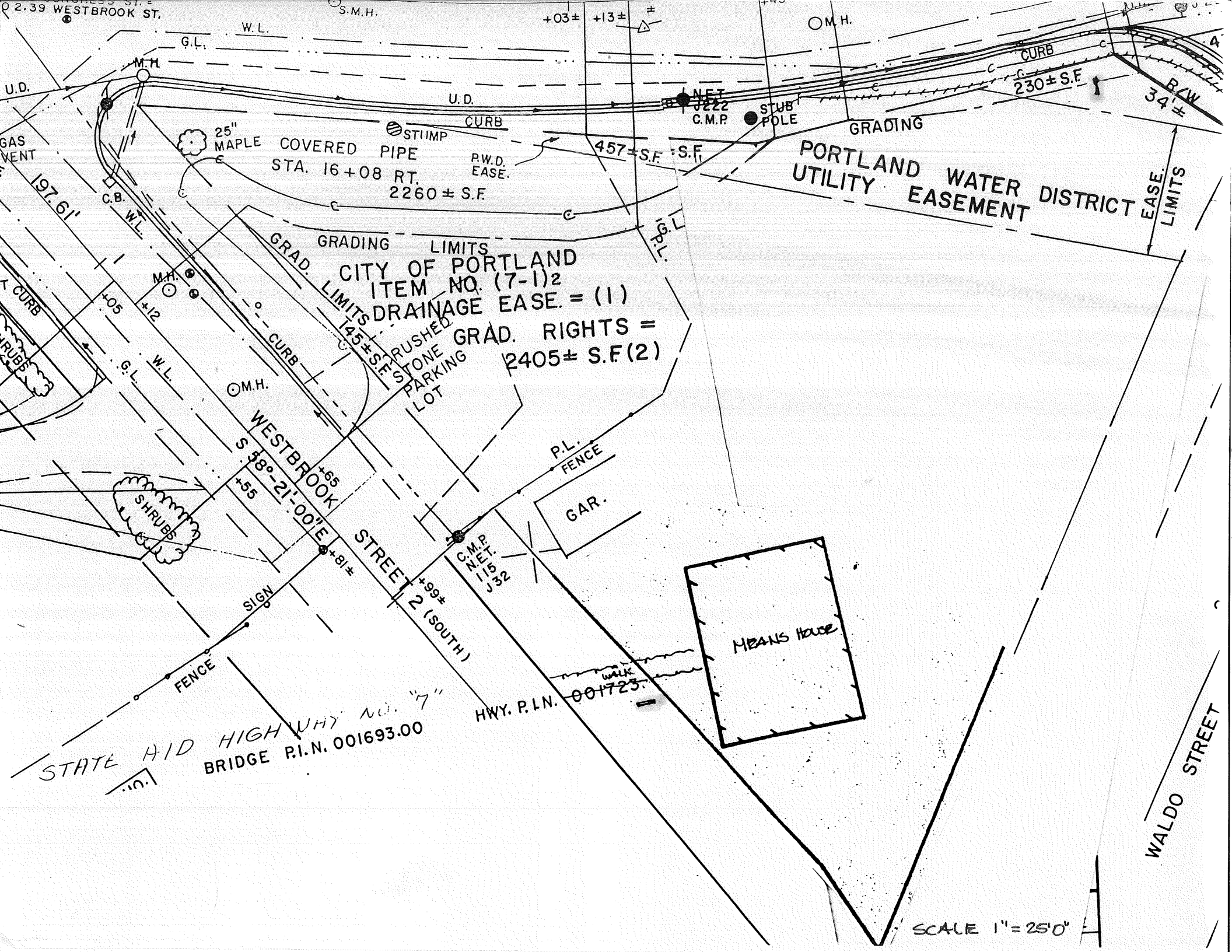

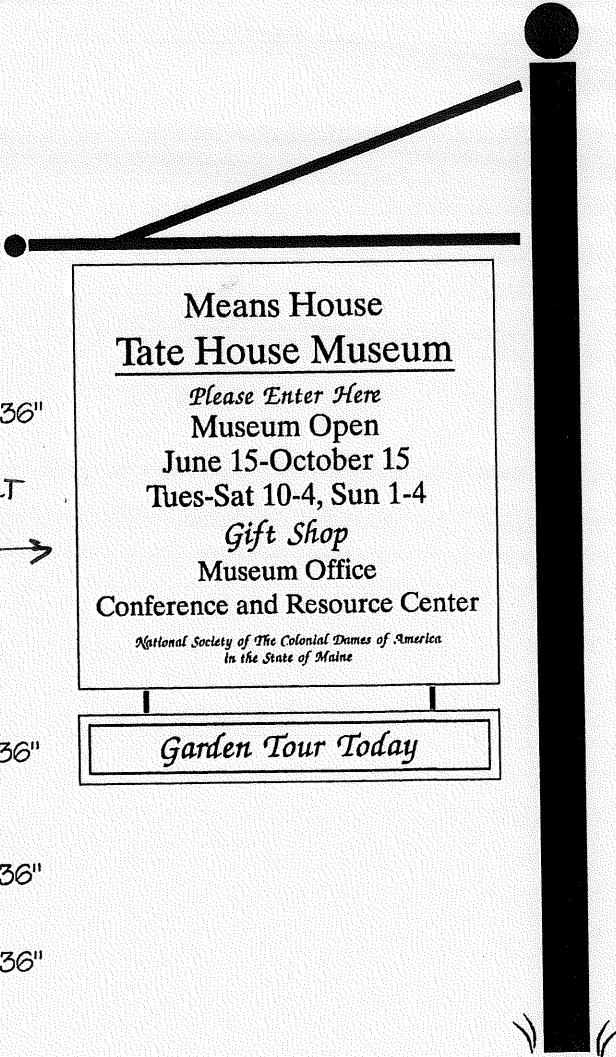
