Hi Doreen,

This is Brad Fries with Northland, the owners of the application pertaining to 216 A006001. Archetype submitted this application on our behalf but I believe they may have used the incorrect cost of construction on the form. They were simply given a number from the GC, Wright-Ryan, which I believe was an older budget number which has since been revised due to some project value engineering and scope reductions. So the new total for the cost of the work is actually **\$1,960,803**.

I believe this would reduce the permit fee down to approximately **\$29,412+/-**.

Sorry to make this request but is there a way we could have this changed on the application form and invoice?
