I am writing regarding an existing 3-unit apartment building located at 1552 Congress Street.

The owner of this property, Brooks Juhring, received a letter and Statement of Deficiency from the Department of Public Safety on January 20, 2011. Since that time we have been working with Brooks on developing a Plan of Correction to provide a second means of egress to the third floor. I have met with various members of your Code Office and Zoning Department, as well as spoken to the Office of the State Fire Marshal to try to come up with a plan that the Owner has the means to implement as quickly as possible.

We have developed a possible solution that would involve us installing a new dormer on top of the existing rear stairwell to provide the required second means of egress from the third floor. With this concept we would be able to accomplish most of the issues at hand, with one exception. This solution places a new stairwell over an existing stairwell that does not meet proper rise, run and overall stair width for a new code compliant egress stairway. The new stair could be built to the proper rise and run standard, however half of the new stair leading to the third floor would be "stacked" over the existing stairway and would therefore be a few inches shy of meeting the 36" clear width requirement.

I described this situation to the Office of the State Fire Marshal and they seemed comfortable with this as a solution even though it would not be 100% in compliance. Given this situation and the restraints of the existing conditions, would the City of Portland allow this to be approved? Are there any other considerations that I should address before completing this plan and submitting it to the State and to the City of Portland?

I would appreciate your input before we put a lot of time and detail into a set of plans for Mr. Juhring. He wants to do the right thing but I am having a difficult time guiding him.

An inspection was conducted at 1552 Congress street Portland ME on 07 Jan 2011 at 1500 hours. In attendance was Mr. Juhring the stated owner or the apartment building. Mr. Juhring stated that permission was given to enter the second floor apartment. This inspection is the result of a complaint received on 01 November 2010. The inspection was conducted using the 2006 edition of the National Fire Protection Association Life Safety Code 101 and Maine Revised Statue Title 25 §2453

The building is a type V (000) construction with three units. The building is not sprinkler protected. The only unit I inspected was the second story unit and only as it applies to title 25 §2453. The City of Portland Fire prevention office inspected the remainder of the building.

The unit has two exits from the second floor and a single center stair from third floor witch serves two bedrooms one on the left and one on the right of the stairs. The bedrooms each have windows that are identified as Egress size by the Portland Fire Prevention officer. The third floor does not have a second means of egress as required by Title 25 §2453
