Hi Steve,

The applications are on our website, <http://www.portlandmaine.gov/1728/Permitting-Inspections>, this would most likely be the Residential Alterations application and many of the items on the checklist will not be applicable. I am open to this being submitted as fast track, but would like to see the drawings first. You would also need to fill out the fast track forms and I could send an email confirmation for it to be eligible that will also need to be included with the documents.

Take a look at the checklist, this will be a good guide, plot plan, foundation plan, section with construction details and termination at the roof, clearances to combustibles, fireplace if applicable.

Also, have the contractor fill out the Chimney Disclosure form that is found at the application list on the website and provide a copy.

When you have things in order send them to me to preview and determine the fast track eligibility prior to your formal submittal.

Hi Steve,

I looked over your information and spoke with my manager for guidance as this is a bit out of the ordinary. Everything looks good in terms of your information except for the following:

1. The plot plan needs to be more clear on the orientation in relation to the yards. Adding the location of the street(s) will solve this. Also, please provide the dimension from the chimney in each yard to the property lines, (or at least the applicable yards).

In addition to this, you will need to do the following in order for this to be eligible for the Fast Track process, with no zoning review:

1. Use schedule "A" as this has additional sign offs at the bottom by you for zoning compliance.

2. You will need to physically cross out part of the 2nd line "first floor deck, stairs, or porch." and write in "exterior chimney, see pre-approval email". Scan this form to submit.

3. Convert this email into a pdf file and submit as this confirms the pre-approval by me for this project to be eligible for the Fast Track schedule A process.

One more item, the heating appliances you will be installing also need an HVAC permit that is available on our website can also be done per the fast track process.

I will be out of the office until next week if you have any questions.
