Dear Mr. Clark:

Permit to construct a 28'-0" x 24'-0" addition as per your plan and which was sustained by your recent zoning ordinance appeal is being issued subject to building code requirements as follows:

1. Corner post on left hand rear corner, as one faces the building from the street, will need to extend in one piece from the 4x6 inch solid sill on the foundation wall to the double 2x4-inch plate at the eaves.
2. The header over the picture window opening will need to be not less than a solid 4x6-inch member if jack studs are enclosed in the mullions as is shown. If jack studs are not to be used then the size and material of the header will need to be approved before the form inspection is called for.

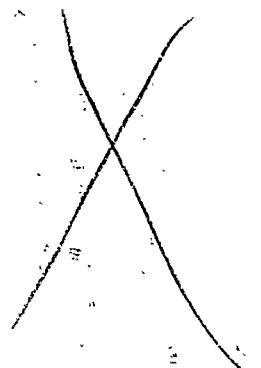
