The situation has come about because the applicant had to move the access to the site over to be opposite Blueberry and this has entailed a very costly easement from MTA for the access drive over MTA land. The area where they would have preferred to have the access is now to have some tree preservation (ie where they own along Congress). MTA would not give them an larger easement (or would do so only with a very big price tag over and above an a large price tag for the drive access) but there is an informal agreement that the applicant can "improve" the area.

They have changed the pin oak to the swamp white oak that you recommended; they have also clarified re treesaves in the southern part of the site in addition to more and relocated trees around the basin.

I have indicated that a note on the plan would suffice regarding the area that you highlighted in your email (given the land ownership) - as they have addressed all of your comments from the previous review and the current review. So there is a new note.....
