Dear Mr Pettingill:

Thank you for your letter dated March 3, 2016 requesting approval to undertake advance site preparation prior to the receipt of a building permit (copy attached). This relates to the proposals for a new 19,000 sq ft office development on LCE #4 within the Portland Technology Park (PTP), as approved on December 8, 2015 by the Portland Planning Board.

As provided in Section 14-532, this letter serves as the written permission from the Planning Authority to commence site preparation work on this project prior to the issuance of a building permit. The permitted advance site work is limited to the removal of trees, stumping, grinding, and perimeter erosion control subject to the following conditions being met prior to the commencement of any work on site (including tree cutting):

- A satisfactory Performance Guarantee shall be posted (at least to cover site stabilization and restoration of the site);
- The Inspection Fee shall be paid;
- The signed subdivision plat shall be recorded;
- The extent of tree clearance is marked on the ground, and is consistent with the approved Site Plan C-03 Rev 4, to the satisfaction of the Planning Division DRC (Phil DiPierro 874-8632) at a meeting on site;
- Erosion and sedimentation control shall be installed in accordance with the approved plans and notes.

Please note that you must obtain any permits that may be required from Public Works for any street openings, and that building permits must be obtained from the Inspections Division prior to the commencement of any construction of any buildings, foundations or structures.

On behalf of Patrons Oxford Insurance I am respectfully requesting approval to perform site preparation work prior to receiving our building permit for Site 4 and the road extension at the Portland Technology Park.
