The permit application and site have been reviewed for a fill permit at the above address. Coordination with DEP was made to confirm whether or not a permit under NRPA was required. No permit is required based on the limits of the fill activity as presented herein and with DEP.

Therefore, a fill permit is granted with the following conditions:

- 1. No fill activity shall extend beyond the existing natural berm as discussed with Mike Clark of MeDEP; the berm is parallel to the embankment where the existing shed is located. This limit of disturbance is less than the 4,300 s.f. of wetland filling allowed without a NRPA permit.
- 2. All fill material shall be composed of natural mineral soil deposits.
- 3. The disturbed area shall be stabilized with 4" of loam, seed and mulch by September 15, 1999. If not stabilized by that date, the applicant shall apply for a permit extension.
