KEY TO PROGRAM

- A** point of land edged with cobblestones and filled with logo sculpture and plantings, banners, open to view of new sign on building face
- B** expanded wildlife park, fenced area continuous with early childhood play zone - includes sand box, stumps, teepees, plantings, etc
- C** early childhood play equipment relocated, mulch play surface, surrounded by paved bike loop
- D** new entry walk with sitting walls on either side for pick up and drop off, new plantings for shade and color
- E** new entry from Capisic, widened sidewalk with patterned pavement, welcome sign for Nason's Corner Park
- F** stone dust pathway around park for jogging and dog walking
- G** grove of trees and modified ropes course over mulch surface
- H** big flat stones create durable play surface and connections from school to park
- I** large paved area for gatherings, sunshine, and games
- J** existing butterfly garden
- K** pea gravel area with water pump, moveable stones and sluice
- L** new parking arrangement for safer building entry, and a bench for bus stop along the esplanade
- M** identity plantings, fence, bollards, lights, banners, and perennials in the esplanade
- N** middle school yard with council ring (stones) and gardens, fenced with gates on either end
- O** stone or paver patio stage with concentric steps, boulders for seating
- P** berms with ornamental trees for playing, sliding, buffering, watching games
- Q** skating rink and football & baseball fields remain
- R** new plantings on city park for shade, picnics
- S** existing parking on Albion St.
- T** new fencing around city park
- U** new location for storage shed and play village
- V** new identity plantings in front of the Jessie' Building
- W** new crosswalk
- X** bike rack area
