2. Please submit a plot plan that includes the dimensions of the new roof structures on the footprint including dimensions showing how far out the new structures extend from existing roof.
3. Submit a simple front elevation sketch of the whole structure and where on the structure the new roof additions will be located.
4. Please specify the material of the support beam and support beam dimensions.
5. Submit a sketch showing how the support beam/bracket will be attached to the house. Are you attaching it to plywood, a stud?
6. Specify whether the doors are existing doors.
