Hi Caitlin -

A question on the sign permit for the Sprint/Radio Shack. Is the unit's frontage definitely 25 feet? A previous permit said it was 28 feet. I wanted to check because the allowed sign square footage for the building sign is 1.5 sf per linear foot of frontage -- so for 25 ' they'd get a 37.5 sf sign, and for 28 ' they'd get a 42 sf sign.

I'm ok in this case breaking the "Sprint" and "Radio Shack" signs into two measurements - the total of the two I calculate as 39.6 sf. This will be OK if they have 28 ' of frontage but too big otherwise.

Please confirm the frontage, and if it's the smaller number, please let me know how the applicant would like to proceed. We approved the existing sign in 2007 by breaking the words and symbol into two pieces (which we don't really do anymore), totaling 36.25 sf on 28' of frontage.
