No need to apologize. I don't mind helping out and this is a fairly simple one.

The deed description is fine except that the composer should add a sentence which clarifies if the bearings are based on magnetic north, true north or grid north. If it's magnetic north, then the year of the magnetic reading needs to be labeled as well. Also, any reference to a survey or survey plan would be helpful.

# Exhibit A needs a few things:

- 1. Label Brighton Avenue;
- 2. Label the Town Line, and label which side is Portland and which side is Westbrook;
- 3. Label the Boundary Line (can't assume it's the same as the Town Line);
- 4. Label the locus property owner and the abutting property owner;
- 5. Add "Magnetic (year)", "True" or "Grid" to the North Arrow, whichever is appropriate;
- 6. Add a description of the Iron marker and Monument shown on the Exhibit;
- 7. Not sure this Exhibit needs that long note about the 10 foot wide strip of land inside the CMP easement.
