This is a Notice of Violation pursuant to Section 12.79 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection will occur on 08/09/2017, at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. Section 4452. This is an appealable decision pursuant to Section 12.80 of the Municipal Code.

Notes: Sec. 12-78. Placing on private property.

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit, place, leave or abandon any old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof, on any private property in the city, except in duly authorized locations. (Code 1968, § 317.3)

Sec. 12-79. Keeping on private property; notice to remove.

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or occupying private property in the city to keep or allow to accumulate any old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof, on private property after having received written notice from the city, by the city manager or by an official designated by the city manager, ordering the removal from the property upon not less than thirty (30) days from receipt of the order of the old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof.

A copy of the order shall be hand delivered or sent by certified mail to the owner or occupant of the private property, or to the owner of the motor vehicle if the owner's identity is known.

The order of removal may be appealed as provided in section
City of Portland Garbage, Wastes and Junk Code of Ordinances Chapter 12 Sec. 12-83 Rev. 3-23-11

12-80. Failure to appeal such order shall render the order final. In the event of an appeal, the time frames established for the removal of the vehicle shall be stayed during the pendency of the appeal. (Code 1968, § 317.4; Ord No. 162-90, 12-10-90)

Comments: Red vehicle without plates in the driveway. Remove or register vehicle within 30 days.
