There are no notes on this plan and as the lots were deeded out of the subdivision, they contained the following language concerning the roads: "Together with the fees in so far as the grantor (J.W. Wilbur Co, Inc.) has the right so to convey the same, of all the streets and ways shown on said plan (Portland Garden, Plan Book 12, Page 23), in common with the owners of the other lots shown on said plan, and subject to the right of all the said lot owners to make any customary use of said streets and ways."

Jordan and Hammond, Inc. was the developer of Sunset Heights, Section E, a twenty lot subdivision portion of Sunset Heights as shown on a plan dated April 1967 and recorded in Plan Book 74, Page 39 in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds. There are no notes on this plan and as the lots were deeded out of the subdivision, they contained the following language: "All other rights, easements, privileges and appurtenances belonging to the granted estate are hereby conveyed."
