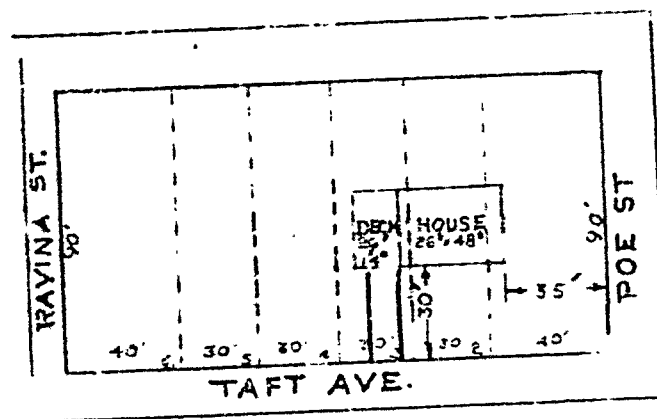

Gentlemen:

Permit to construct a 1-story frame dwelling 48'8" x 26'8" with carport 14' x 26' is issued herewith subject to the following Building Code requirements:

1. Plans do not indicate a nailing strip where floor joists butt against 6x10 build-up girder. It is necessary that you provide a 2x3 nailing strip or use timber hangers at this location.
2. The plans do not indicate anchor bolts. It is necessary that the bottom member of the box sill be anchored at the corners and 6' on centers.
3. Where the box sill runs parallel to the floor joists it is necessary that it be doubled. (at each end of the building).
4. A 4x6 header is sufficient over the picture window in the living room provided mullions are to be used as shown.

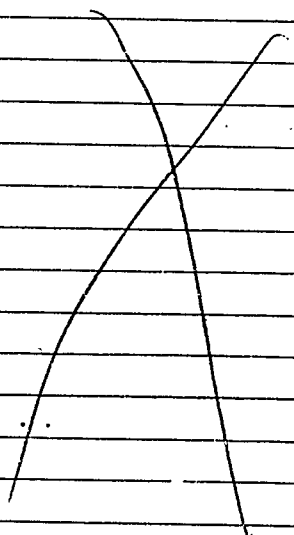

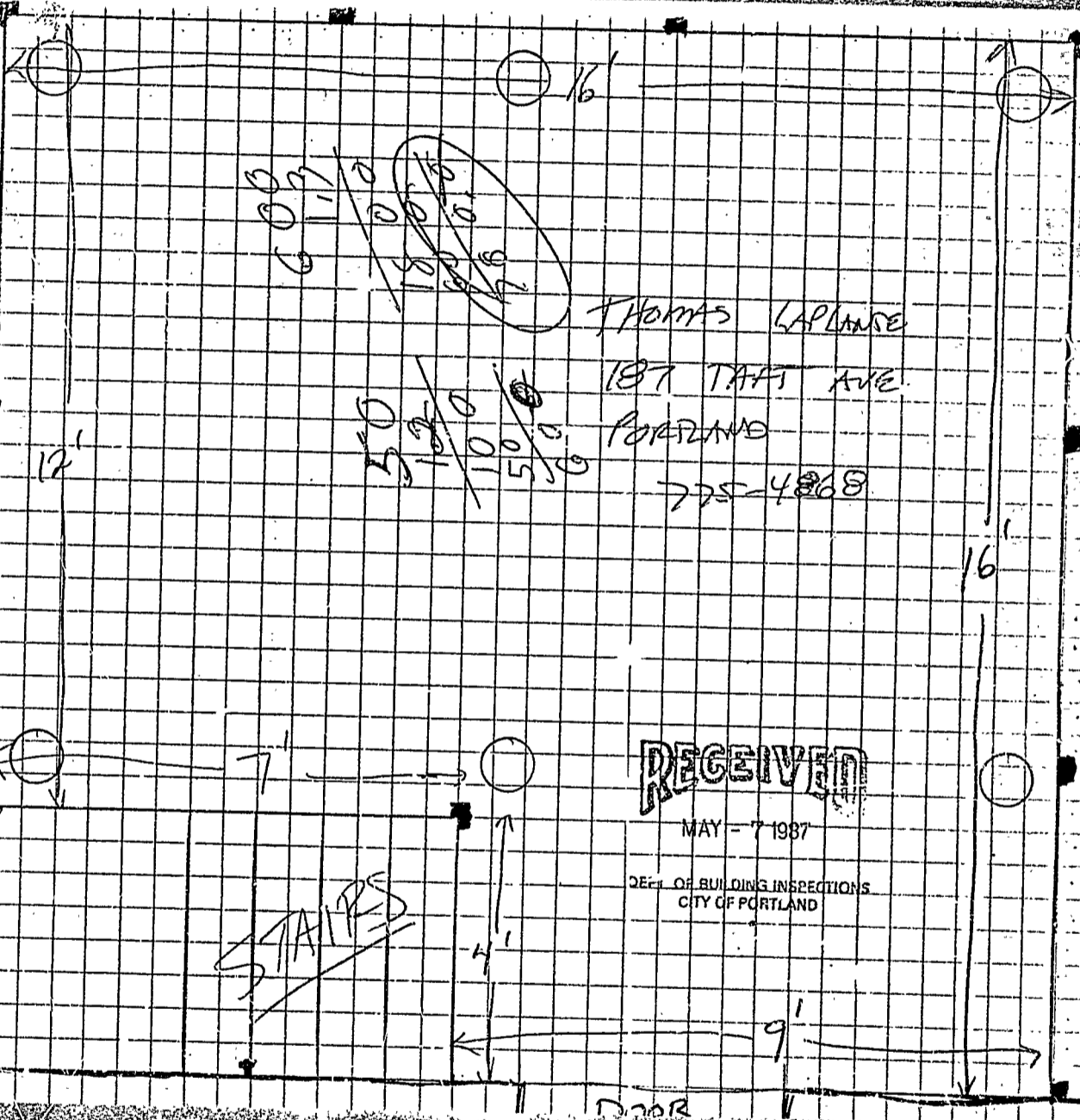

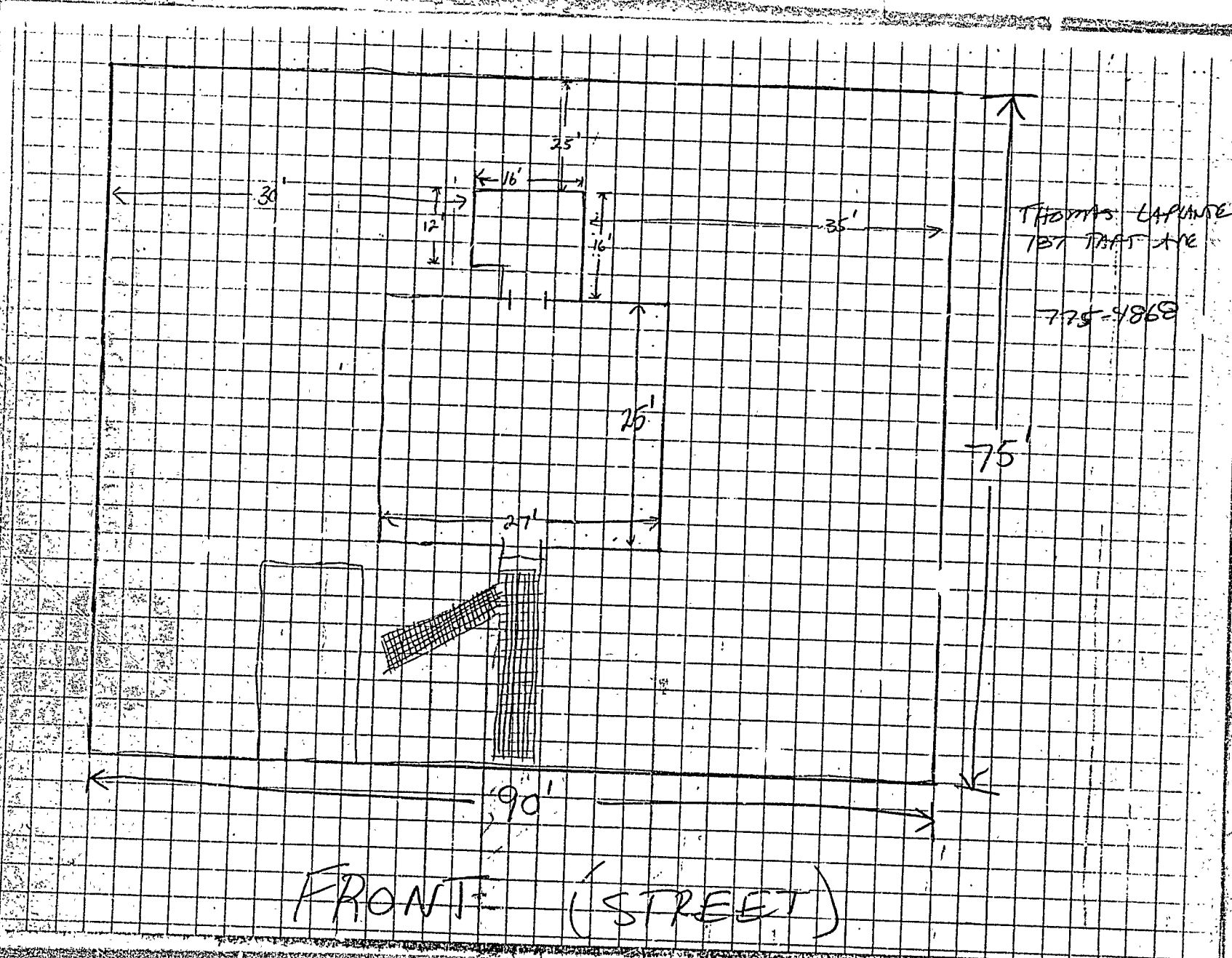
