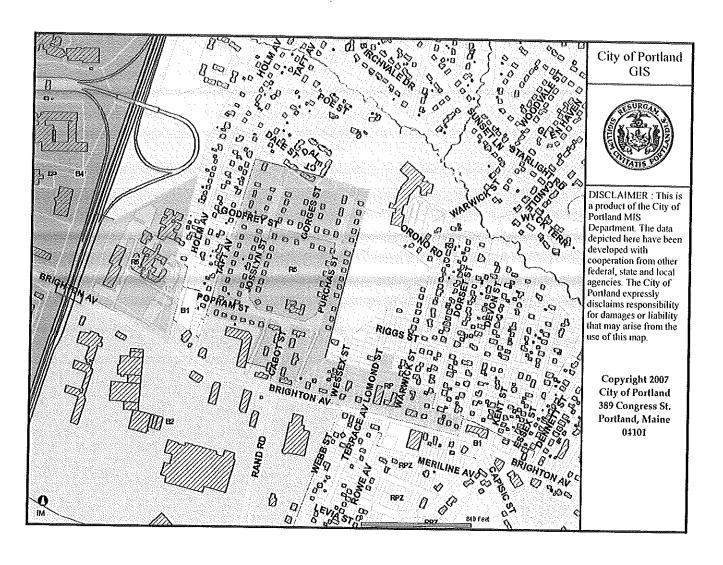

The uses include a homework area, tutoring and a game room. The applicant is stating that only 7% of the lot is being covered by structures. There are a total of four exterior parking spaces shown with an existing covered garage, probably for maintenance vehicles. The number of spaces are reasonable considering that the residential units have their own parking spaces and the kids would be living in this project. There are no outside people who will be using this space that I am aware of.
