## General Classroom/Office facilities

Toilet fixture counts were determined using the design capacity of 558 students and an anticipated staff count of 90 . First floor classrooms serving Pre-K through $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade have single user toilets with in their classrooms to serve that population. Staff restrooms are also located within each wing of the building. On the second floor, multi-user toilets are provided along with two any sex toilets for students. Four staff toilets are also provided on this floor.

## Assembly Spaces

The fixture counts for the assembly spaces were calculated with the assumption that either the cafeteria or the gymnasium would be used for functions, not both simultaneously (there is a single stage so only one large production could be held). Being the largest space, the gymnasium was used to calculate the necessary fixtures. At 5,446 sf, this results in 778 people on the floor plus approximately 176 fixed bleacher seats results in an assembly occupancy of 954 . We have assumed a ratio of 50/50 for male to female
