An evaluation of your property at 22 Glenhaven East on September 8, 1999 revealed that the premises fails to comply with Section 12 of the Garbage and Solid Waste Removal Code of the City of Portland. (Attached is a description of the violations and copies of the referenced code sections.)

The following is a list of items in the rear yard:

Discarded miscellaneous, metal, sheet metal, old motors, tires, auto parts, junk boat, gas cans, plywood, and miscellaneous rubble.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 12-100 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 15 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur 15 days from the date of this letter, at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the code and in title 30-A M.R.S.A. Ss 4452.
