The Portland Fire Department, in response to your report of the presence or suspected presence of carbon monoxide responded to your residence or place of business. The Portland Fire Department determined while our personnel were there:

1. The level of carbon monoxide was either within acceptable levels or was not detectable with our monitoring equipment
2. An elevated level of carbon monoxide was present and monitored at 140 parts per million with our monitoring equipment.

- 4. YOU SHOULD CONSIDER VACATING THE PREMISES UNTIL A TECHNICIAN HAS CERTIFIED THAT THEY ARE SAFE FOR THEIR USUAL USE.**
