Responses to your questions above.

- 1. State Farm Insurance sales office.
- 2. Square Footages
 - 1. 88sf Front Seating area and public are for purchasing baked goods
 - 2. 308sf Behind the counter and kitchen area. Includes the bathroom.
- 3. There is an existing bathroom in the back right corner of the space. We are not doing any work in this room and it will not be a public restroom.
- 4. We are installing an ADA counter, but we are not changing the existing entry or the bathroom.

I am handling the plan review for the above building permit. Can you provide the following information/clarifications:

- 1. What type of business was previously within this specific tenant space.
- 2. Provide dimensions of the proposed tenant space. In order to calculate the occupant load, I specifically need the breakdown of the square footages of the bakery seating area versus kitchen area.
- 3. The plans do not show a bathroom in the tenant space. Please clarify.
- 4. Provide ADA compliance per the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design. This should include an ADA compliant bathroom, at least 5% disbursed seating per Section 226 and an ADA service counter per Section 227.
- 5. Clarify the use on the second floor and where access to this floor is. I am assuming it is not through the tenant space. Please clarify.
