Description of Site & Conditions: Level backyard in residential neighborhood of Portland

Comments: The best location for the ramp is at the rear door from the kitchen, descending to a large deck in the back yard. It is 42 inches from the ground to the door threshold at the back door, and 5 inches from the door threshold to the deck. This door is 31 inches wide and from the outside pushes open from left to right. There is a storm door that from the outside pulls open from the right to left. The deck is 13 feet wide and 16 feet long. There is a water faucet just beyond the north edge of the deck, and a propane tank beside the stairs leading to the detached garage on the south side of the house.

The ramp should start with a landing level at the door, and descend north 5 feet to the deck. After removing the handrail, the ramp should then be installed on the northwest corner of the deck and proceed west 10 feet to a small landing, then south 15 feet to another small landing, and finally turning east 17 feet to end on the paved walkway. A gate should be installed at the top of the stairs.

Funding is from "Portland". The home is not located on a floodplain and no tie downs are required.
