To Whom It May Concern:

I am applying for the Residential Additions/Alterations Permit to make the necessary renovations to my non-comforming dwelling (application #201501305) in order to get it up to code to make it a legal dwelling. It was being used illegally as an in-law apartment when I purchased the property back in May. It was formerly a garage/barn. I plan to do the following work under this building permit (applications for electric and HVAC upgrades will follow). - Remove the kitchen and bathroom cabinets and install updated ones.

Cosmetic:

- Paint the ceiling and walls and install wainscotting in the living area
- Remove tile flooring and install Pergo flooring.
- Update windows.
