Kelly -

You may not have to submit a permit at all. When you say that you want to put up a cage to store the propane tanks you use for your paving and seal coating businesses, what exactly does the cage consist of? Are you just putting it on the ground or are you pouring a concrete pad etc? If you are just putting it on the ground, you do not need a permit. You just need to make sure that it is suitably screened from the public right of way and abutting properties by a fence or planting.
