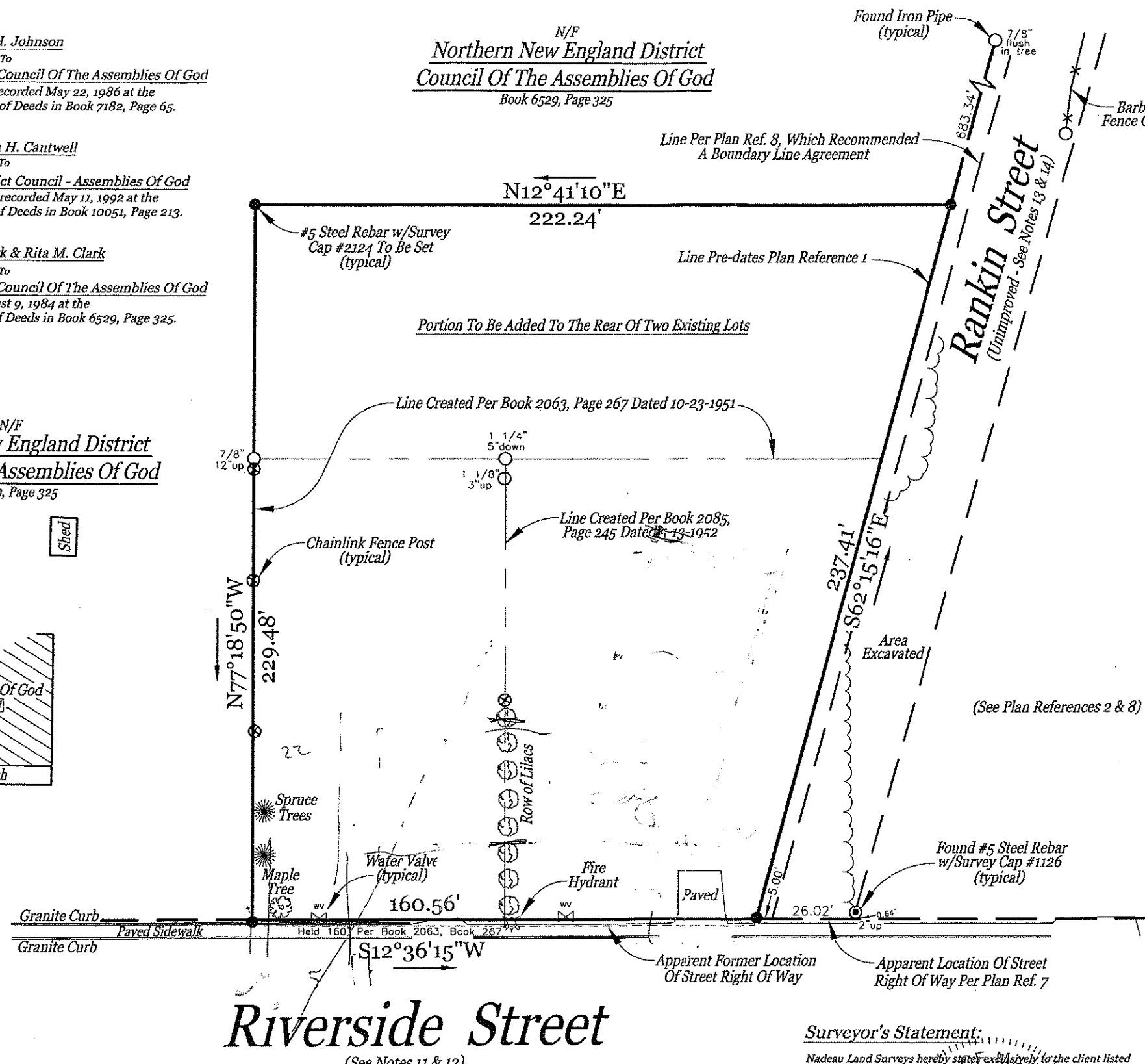

- Proposed Area of Locus Parcel is 43,898 square feet (1.01 acres).
- The apparent right of way lines depicted on this plan are based on the Plan References listed hereon and monumentation found in the field.
- Riverside Street was formerly known as Old Town House Road and the Road from Deering Poor Farm to Pride's Bridge. This section was relocated December 15, 1924 per Portland Street Records Book 2, Page 192 as 49.5 feet wide, and altered September 8, 1971 per Book 2, Page 347 and widened to 60 feet wide (see CCRD Book 3191, Page 123, of same date for Certificate of Taking of Property). See CCRD Book 14925, Page 41, dated April 14, 1999, for MDOT Notice of Layout and Taking.
- Per CCRD Book 13326, Page 19, dated September 3, 1997, Order Excepting From Deemed Vacation, Staff Recommended to Continue/ Vacate Rankin Street: "vacate everything beyond second house", of which the extent is unclear.
- Rankin Street is part of the Riverton Home-Sites subdivision per Plan Reference 2, appears to be of irregular width, and is not dimensioned on said plan. The Locus Parcel does not appear to have any rights or interest in Rankin Street.
