I went out and visited Mr. Roper today. He has a pretty good sized pile of shingles and gobs of mud over there so that he can't get his truck into the shingle pile to get it loaded up and over to Riverside. His truck is getting fixed. The daily loads of shingles his crews are generating are going directly over to Riverside.

Here is how I left it.

I will give him 2 weeks to get all of the waste shingles and other stuff out of there AND get his lot "built" using gravelly material that will let him actually work in there to keep his exemption as allowed in Chapter 402. He will then call me and I will inspect.

If that doesn't happen, he will lose his exemption and will need to do something different.
