Please find below that answers to your questions.

- 1. Is the pad reinforced? Yes, the Pad is precast 4ft. by 4ft. by 8inch. MFG by Swans.
- 2. Does the pad sit on a frost wall? No, it sits on 8 Plus inch of crashed gravel
- 3. How thick is the pad? 4 inch per Kohler
- 4. Does the generator weight require a minimum concrete strength? No, whereas the generator is mounted on a steel frame raising the unit approximately 30 inches above grade Generator weighs 1,960 lbs.
