## Life Safety Plan:

Given the rather straightforward nature of the plan submittal, life safety information has been shown on a supplemental code plan. Fire ratings are not required, Travel distances (common path and Max Travel) are both noted well under requirements. Fire extinguishers and EXIT sign locations noted and emergency lighting is not required.

NFPA 101 and IBC 2009 Code Summary (IBC Items in **BOLD and underlined**):

Use Type – Residential Board and Care / RESIDENTIAL 4

Interconnected smokes only, CO detectors in hallways

Portable fire extinguishers – none / SAME AS NFPA

Kitchen Extinguishing – ANSL System at stove / NONE REQUIRED
