- ☐ Cross sections w/framing details
- ☐ Detail of any new walls or permanent partitions
- ☐ Floor plans and elevations
- ☐ Window and door schedules
- ☐ Foundation plans with rebar specifications and required drainage and damp proofing (if applicable)
- ☐ Detail egress requirements and fire separations
- ☐ Insulation R-factors of walls, ceilings, floors and U-factors of windows as per the IECC 2003
- ☐ Complete the Accessibility Certificate and The Certificate of Design
- ☐ A statement of special inspections as required per the IBC 2003
- ☐ Complete electrical and plumbing layout.
- ☐ Mechanical drawings for any specialized equipment such as furnaces, chimneys, gas equipment, HVAC equipment (air handling) or other types of work that may require special review.
- ☐ Reduced plans or electronic files in PDF format are required if originals are larger than 11" x 17".
- ☐ Per State Fire Marshall, all new bathrooms must be ADA compliant.

Separate permits are required for internal & external plumbing, HVAC and electrical installations.

Nine (9) copies of the minor (< 10,000 sf) or major (> 10,000 sf) site plan application is required that includes:

- ☐ A stamped boundary survey to scale showing north arrow, zoning district and setbacks to a scale of  $\geq 1" = 20'$  on paper  $\geq 11" \times 17"$

- ☐ Location and dimensions of parking areas and driveways, street spaces and building frontage
- ☐ Finish floor or sill elevation (based on mean sea level datum)
- ☐ Location and size of both existing utilities in the street and the proposed utilities serving the building
- ☐ Existing and proposed grade contours
- ☐ Silt fence (erosion control) locations


